POLICY ON CANADIAN MIDWIFERY REGISTRATION EXAMINATION

The *Midwifery Act Regulations* requires midwifery candidates to complete registration examinations. The registration examination approved by the Midwifery Regulatory Council is the Canadian Midwifery Registration Examination. (CMRE).

The CMRE is a national written examination designed to assess applicants for midwifery registration to ensure that they meet entry-level competency standards set out in the Canadian Competencies for Midwives. Its goal is to ensure that midwives gaining registration are competent and safe practitioners providing a consistent standard of care across Canada.
