

MIDWIFERY REGULATORY COUNCIL OF NOVA SCOTIA (MRCNS)

POLICY ON CANADIAN MIDWIFERY EDUCATION PROGRAM (MEP) APPROVAL PROCESS

The Midwifery Regulatory Council may approve a new Canadian Midwifery Education Program (MEP) without undertaking its own approval process as long as it meets the following criteria:

- The program has been approved by another Canadian midwifery regulatory body for registration in that province or territory;
- The program or regulatory body is able to provide a report on either the regulatory body's review or internal review of the program;
- The report contains information that is sufficient and satisfactory to the Council.
