POLICY ON CANADIAN MIDWIFERY REGISTRATION EXAMINATION (CMRE)

The *Nursing and Midwifery Regulations* require midwifery candidates to complete an approved registration examination. The registration examination that is approved and administered by the Canadian Midwifery Regulatory Council (CMRC) is the Canadian Midwifery Registration Exam (CMRE).

The CMRE is a national written examination designed to assess applicants for midwifery registration to ensure that they meet entry-level competency standards set out in the Canadian Competencies for Midwives. Its goal is to ensure that midwives gaining registration are competent and safe practitioners providing a consistent standard of care across Canada.
