

NSNMR REGISTRATION & LICENSURE POLICY

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants seeking licensure for clinical midwifery practice must have:

- 1125 hours or attendance at 40 births in the clinical practice of midwifery in the 5 years immediately before their application for registration; or
- 450 hours or attendance at 12 births in the clinical practice of midwifery in the year before their application for registration.
- meet continuing competency requirements approved by the Nova Scotia Nursing and Midwifery Regulator (NSNMR)

The clinical practice of midwifery according to the *Nursing and Midwifery Regulations* means the provision of antepartum, intrapartum, postpartum, newborn and infant care and sexual and reproductive health as a primary care provider.
