

Effective June 30, 2026, the Nova Scotia Nursing and Midwifery Regulator (NSNMR) was formed as a multi-profession regulator, replacing the former the Midwifery Regulatory Council of Nova Scotia (MRCNS) and the Nova Scotia College of Nursing (NSCN). NSNMR will regulate licensed practical nurses (LPNs), registered nurses (RNs), registered psychiatric nurses (RPNs), nurse practitioners (NPs) and registered midwives (RMs) on behalf of the public.

While this document contains current information about this topic, some content references MRCNS and previous legislation before June 30, 2026. We appreciate your patience as we continue updating our documents to align with our new name and legislation.

Fees:

Practising Licence \$500

Practising - Conditional Licence \$250

Schedule:

Online licence renewal opens February 1

Renewal applications and QAP Reports are due on or before March 1 annually

Late Renewal (including late QAP reports)

- Between March 2nd and April 1st \$50
- After April 1st \$150

Payment Options:

For licence renewal, the full amount payable is due on or before March 1st.

The Nova Scotia Nursing and Midwifery Regulator (NSNMR) accepts cheques, bank drafts and money orders in Canadian funds payable to the Nova Scotia Nursing and Midwifery Regulator, Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). You can also pay by credit card upon completion of the online application, which can be found at mrcns.ca.
